

STOP

Launch Box Competition

THURSDAY, Sept. 1 • 4 p.m. at the ThunderDome

Staging at 3 p.m. • Drivers Briefing 3:30 p.m.

ACTIVITY DESCRIPTION: The Launch Box Competition is a single car timed event. Each competitor starts in the designated Launch Box racing to the Stop Box 60 feet away. A driver's failure to stop in the Stop Box results in elimination from the event. It's a test of acceleration and braking in a mere 60 feet. Mustangs will be selected in a random order. Drivers will begin this event in the Start Box, watching for the drop of the green flag to begin their run.

At 60 feet there will be a Stop Box. If drivers fail to stop within the Stop Box, they will be eliminated from the event. A red flag will be used to signal drivers to abort their launch or travel. Drivers are required to

stop immediately upon the signal of the red flag and wait for further instructions - colored lights may replace or be used in conjunction with the red flag.

Burnout Competition THURSDAY, Sept. 1

Immediately following the LaunchBox Competition

at the ThunderDome

ACTIVITY DESCRIPTION: The Burnout Competition is a single-car event. Drivers are selected at random. They will enter the burnout pad and attempt to handle their cars in such a manner as to spin its drive wheels to produce smoke for a minimum of 30 seconds and a maximum of 90 seconds.

Upon entering the burnout pad, an easy release band will be tied to the driver's wrist and held by referees to notify driver of the 30-second mark, as well as the 90-second mark. This is done because visibility can be impaired and visual signals may be missed.

A green flag will be dropped to signal the start of a driver's burnout. At 30 seconds, the easy release wristband will be tugged to signal the 30 second mark. A red flag, as well as mulitple tugs on the wristband signals the end of the driver's run and the driver is required to shut down immediately — a red flashing light may replace or act in conjunction with the red flag.

To participate in the Burnout Competition, petition, you must purchase a blue wristband.

POINT CRITERIA: During the competition, Mustangs are judged on:

- Instant Smoke
- Constant Revolutions
- Driver Control (including safey in and around the burnout box)
- Constant Smoke
- Use of Burnout Box
- Crowd Reaction
- Judges award up to 5 points for each criteria met.
- Maximum points achievable is 30 points.
- Drivers who have consumed alcohol prior to this event will not be allowed to compete.

- A FEW RULES APPLY TO BOTH EVENTS! All drivers are required to:
- Produce a valid driver's license and vehicle registration
- Inspect and show their vehicle is in safe operating condition to SMR officials
- Sign inspection and release forms
- Wear a helmet and seat belt
- All loose items must be secured or removed before competition
- NO DANGEROUS DRIVING in and around event area or to and from burnout box. Violation of this rule will disqualify you immediately and you will be eliminated from SMR events without refund!

• Black Hills Poker Run 2022 •

- **#1 Kickstart Travel Center, 12998 SD Hwy 34** First Poker Run stamp is at the Kickstart Travel Center located three miles east of Sturgis next to the ThunderDome. Be sure to fill up with Premium gas.
- **#2 Sturgis Dragway, Hwy 79 -** Your second stamp is the Sturgis Dragway to take a leisurely or fast run down the track. Turn left out of KickStart onto Highway 34. Approximately 3/4 of a mile, turn left onto Highway 79. Sturgis Dragway is a mile from the turnoff on your left. **The track will only be open from 8am-10am.**
- **#3 Knuckle Saloon, 918 Harley-Davidson Way Stamp #3** is the Knuckle Saloon. A perfect location for breakfast. As you leave the Drag Strip, go back into Sturgis. At the second operating stop light, turn left.
- **#4 Three Forks Country Store, 23820 Hwy 385** As you travel to your fourth stamp, take a scenic drive on Vancocker Canyon Road. Once you hit Nemo Road; take a right and follow this to Highway 385. Upon reaching Highway 385, turn left and head south. The Three Forks Country Store is your destination. Don't forget to pickup your Hill City information and gift bag courtesy of Hill City Chamber of Commerce.
- **#5 Custer Chamber of Commerce, 615 Washington, Custer** How you drive to the fifth stamp Custer City Chamber of Commerce is your choice. You may want to go through Custer State Park via way of the Needles Highway, or feel free to go through Keystone to see Mt. Rushmore. You can also drive on Highway 385 straight to Custer.

We are proud to have the city of Custer as our host this year for the poker run. You will be able to park on Main Street if there is an open parking spot. Also, the side street at the City Chamber of Commerce building will be available. You must go to the chamber building to receive your info bag and \$10.00 "Custer Cash" which is good anywhere in the city of Custer. Have lunch in Custer and shop in the great stores along Main Street.

 Take any route you desire to return back to Sturgis; however, a bonus card will be given for a picture of you and your Mustang anywhere in the Black Hills.







SMR Autocross events are low to medium speed car control emphasizing safety. This is an elimination event.

DRIVER'S BRIEFING

A compulsory driver's briefing will be held at 12:30 p.m. on Friday, Sept. 2, and at 8:45 a.m. on Sunday, Sept. 4 All drivers are required to attend.

The course will be defined using traffic cones.

One driver at a time negotiates the course laid out with cones and flags testing their skill against the clock.

Time penalties are charged for disturbing cones and failing to stop in designated area. The penalty is 1 second per cone and 1 second for failing to stop in stop zone. Each car will require inspection and driver must have appropriate safety equipment.

The loser of each race will be eliminated, with the winner racing again until a total of 16 cars are left. These cars (the Sweet 16) will receive an award and cash prize.

Eight of the Sweet 16 will move on to the next round. These Elite 8 will receive an additional cash prize.

Four cars will move on to the next round from the Elite 8. This group is called the Fantastic 4. The Fantastic 4 receive an additional cash prize and the chance to bet their winnings on the next round.

The Dynamic Duo will be the last two cars to move on from the Fantastic 4. The Dynamic Duo receives a cash prize and can bet their winnings or keep them for the final round.

The final race between the Dynamic Duo is a best three (3) out of five (5) elimination races that will determine who takes 1st and 2nd place.

Cash prizes and trophies will be awarded.

Please be sure to read all the instructions and directions below to make this years Show the best and smoothest yet! We have had many changes to our Main Street within the last five years, please be patient with us as we adapt to the changes while parking.

To participate in the Show & Shine, you must purchase a ₩ħft⊕ wristband.

RULES OF THE SHOW:

Do not activate your alarm or lock your car on Main.

Car bling / signs / trophies must be inside or on your car, nothing on the street. SMR is not liable for damage or theft of these items!

DO NOT leave before the 4 pm end of show. This could result in a DQ. SMR has allotted ample time to get to parade line up and drags. I repeat, DO NOT leave early – Judges need the whole 6 hours to finish the 500+ cars.

BE ON TIME

CLASSING

Pages 18 and 19 list all the different classes of Mustangs competing in the show. You will need to enter your own car into the appropriate class. Participants will compete against each other in that exact class for a gold, silver, or bronze.

DASH CARDS

The dash card given to you at registration and will be used specifically on Saturday for the show. You MUST have the card displayed on the driver side dash. Car numbers MUST be on the passenger side top corner of windshield or you will not get picture taken.

STAGING AREA

Very important! Enter the community center's parking lot on 4th Street and Lazelle. Follow the STAFF's instructions, get your picture taken with your car. You will be checked into the show electronically. If this step is skipped, YOUR CAR WILL NOT BE JUDGED. Then follow the cones to the class lineup at Lynn's Dakotamart parking lot. There you will be subcatorgized into lanes, then shuttled by a UTV to Main in small groups to be parked. Stay in the lane you are instructed too! Pull all the way up to the car in front of you, the lanes fill up quickly.


